New Puppy Shopping List:

Bring when picking up the dog:

- Square Clothes Basket: This will help with the ride home. Some dogs will need to be placed in the dog carrier while being transported home due to their small size or if they get car sickness. A Clothes Basket works well so the puppy can have its water and food in bowls and area to walk around and potty if needed on a long ride home.
- <u>Blankets/Bedding:</u> Will come in handy for dogs to snuggle up in on the ride home and also keeps them warm where they will not catch a cold or chill.
- <u>Food Bowls:</u> This will be needed in case of a long ride home; puppies need to be able to eat and drink water when they are hungry or thirsty. (use stainless steel or ceramic with no painting in the inside. Plastic can absorb bacteria and smell)

Supplies to have ready at home:

- **REQUIRED—Pack and Play Playpen:** An invaluable tool, especially at the beginning. Avoid crating a dog for more than 5 hours. Place safe toys inside and blankets. You might also want to add a heating pad wrapped in a towel or blanket keep on low heat.
- Baby gates: A good confinement alternative. Make sure dog can't get head/paws caught in gate, can't chew threw or knock down the gate or jump the gate. Small puppies will need this in case of stairs where they might can crawl to and fall down.
- **Bedding:** easy to clean, thick enough for comfort.
- Water and food bowls: use stainless steel or ceramic with no painting in the inside.
- <u>Flea comb/Brush:</u> check for fleas, and comb to aid the skin. Good "shedding" control, too. Remember to brush daily; good for skin and can be better than bathing. (Lil-Paws Products are wonderful)
- Grooming supplies: get the right tools for your dog if you're going to bathe, clip claws and cut fur yourself. Different coats require different brushes. (Fresh n' Clean Supplies-Shampoo, Conditioner and grooming sprays)

<u>Food:</u> Puppy needs to stay on the food that the breeder has had them on. (**Royal Canin Products**) Use a good grade of dog food. Premium dog food can lead to lower vet bills. Dry food is good for teeth and digestion. **No table-scrap feeding**. Makes them sick and Table scraps encourages begging. It's your job to keep food out of reach.
